What is at the camp?

The camp includes two dormitories (24 & 36 beds), a community room (with a TV and karaoke machine), dining area (pack lunches available) and a games room (with pool tables, football table and table tennis). The dormitories have showers, toilets and wash areas. All bedding is provided. A warden is always on site.

What fun stuff is there to do?

A playground with swings, a sandpit, and climbing frame as well as a picnic area, covered play area, BBQ and football goals.
